Eduroam is a free Wi-Fi service that is used by educational and research institutions all over the world. It allows students and staff to log in with the same details at any of them.

If you have an Apple or Android device, simply select the Eduroam Wi-Fi connection and enter your username (Identity) & password in the following format:

- Username/Identity: Your student matriculation number followed by @sruc.ac.uk (e.g S00012345@sruc.ac.uk)
- Password: The password you use to log into the Student Desktop and computers when you're on campus
- Please select “Do not validate” under CA Certificate options
